

Jobs Created by Government from Jan. 2017 to March 2018

* The total number of people employed within the formal sector across the country from January 2017 to March 2018 is **1,096,404**.

* Out of the 1,096,404 jobs created, **987,461 (90.06%)** were as a result of the interventions of the various sectors

* The remaining **108,943** were employed into the formal Private Sector (according to records from SSNIT).
